VILLAGE OF HAREYSBURG RESOLUTION 2020-18

A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THAT MONEY OBTAINED BY THE CITY UNDER OHIO HOUSE BILL 481 WILL BE EXPENDED SOLELY AS REQUIRED UNDER HB 481 AND CREATING A NEW FUND FOR RECEIPT OF SUCH MONEY

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act, 116 Public Law 136, (the CARES Act) was signed into law by the President of the United States on March 27, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio General Assembly established a process for distributing funds provided by the "Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act" in H.B. 481 of the 133rd General Assembly (H.B. 481); and

WHEREAS, H.B. 481 requires subdivisions receiving funds under Section 1 of the act, to pass a resolution affirming that funds from the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund may be expended only to cover costs of the subdivision consistent with the requirements of section 5001 of the CARES Act as described in 42 U.S.C. 801(d), and any applicable regulations before receiving said funds; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Harveysburg (aka Harveysburg Corporation) is requesting its share of funds from the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Harveysburg that the Council affirms that all funds received from the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund pursuant to H.B. 481 be expended only to cover costs of the subdivision consistent with the requirements of section 5001 of the CARES Act as described in 42 U.S.C. 801(d), and any applicable regulations and guidance only to cover expenses that:

- (1) Are necessary expenditures incurred due to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19);
- (2) Were not accounted for in the Village of Harveysburg's most recently approved budget as of March 27, 2020; and
- (3) Were incurred during the period that begins on March 1, 2020, and ends on December 30, 2020.

Section 1. FURTHERMORE, in compliance with H.B. 481, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Harveysburg that the Village Fiscal Officer take all necessary action to:

(1) On or before October 15, 2020, pay any unencumbered balance of money in the Village of Harveysburg's local coronavirus relief fund to the County Treasurer;
