VILLAGE OF HARVEYSBURG

RESOLUTION: 2019-<u>033-</u>

A resolution adopting the Warren County 2015 Hazard Mitigation Plan, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Village of Harveysburg, Warren County, Ohio is vulnerable to natural hazards which may result in loss of life and property, economic hardship, and threats to public health and safety, and

WHEREAS, Section 322 of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (DMA 2000) requires state and local governments to develop and submit for approval to the President a mitigation plan that outlines processes for identifying their respective natural hazards, risks, and vulnerabilities, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Harveysburg acknowledges the requirements of Section 322 of DMA 2000 to have an approved Hazard Mitigation Plan as a prerequisite to receiving post-disaster Hazard Mitigation Grant Program Funds, and

WHEREAS, the Warren County 2015 Hazard Mitigation Plan (see Exhibit A) has been developed by the Warren County Emergency Management Agency in cooperation with other county departments, and officials and citizens of the Village of Harveysburg, and

WHEREAS, a public involvement process consistent with the requirements of DMA 2000 was conducted to develop the Warren County 2015 Hazard Mitigation Plan, and

WHEREAS, the Warren County 2015 Hazard Mitigation Plan recommends mitigation activities that will reduce loss to life and property affected by both natural hazards that face the County and its municipal governments,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the council of the Village of Harveysburg, Warren County, Ohio:

Section 1. The Warren County 2015 Hazard Mitigation Plan (Exhibit A) is hereby adopted as the official Hazard Mitigation Plan of the Village of Harveysburg, and

Section 2. The respective officials and agencies identified in the implementation strategy of the Warren County 2015 Hazard Mitigation Plan are hereby directed to implement the recommended activities assigned to them.

Section 4: This Resolution was adopted in an open public session pursuant to section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5: This Resolution shall be deemed an emergency measure for the Village welfare and thereby the three readings as required by law are waived, and this Resolution shall become and be in effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
